## TEACHING -LEARNING APPROACH

The course consists of two hours of lectures, discussions and micro-teaching sessions at the university and 6 hours of field experience in schools. Active participation of each student is required during discussions and presentations. Students are required to teach at least two full lessons and some parts of the lesson according to their weekly schedule in schools.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

To be successful in this course students are expected to:

- come to class prepared to demonstrate effective participation in class discussions;
- teach two full lessons successfully in schools;
- attend 70% of theoretical hours and 80% of practice hours for a pass grade. Students are responsible for tracking absences;
- submit the reports and assignments regulary and in time;
- demonstrate the attitude, behaviour, competence and confidence of an effective teacher;
- · avoid plagiarism.
